Education Report

- Intent was to identify options for supporting the development of health authority safety and quality leaders.
- Report was informed by a skills assessment survey and interviews with leading programs.
- Recommendations for providing QI educational opportunities presented.
- Working group has reviewed draft and report will be finalized shortly.



Recommendations

- 1) Comprehensive quality improvement course – Intermountain Health Care's Advanced Training Program.
- 2) Existing opportunities by other organizations– raise awareness and support spread.
- 3) Break down health authority and sector divides – sharing knowledge across boundaries.
- 4) Original programming – webinar series.



Recommendation 1 – Intermountain ATP

- Long course with an applied learning option was seen as a key to address the needs.
- ATP recommended for a variety of reasons:
 - Logistics and feasibility
 - Curriculum
 - Spread potential
